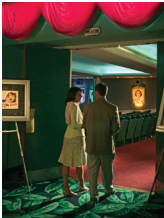
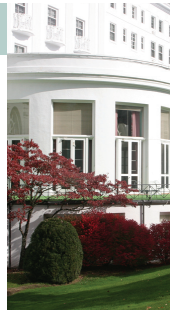


HISTORY

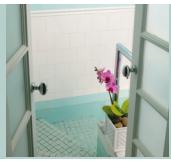

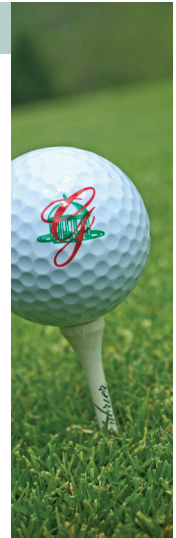
GOLF AT THE GREENBRIER
